☐ "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
\square "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
☐ "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
□ "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
□ "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
